### **FSM Update**

Huge thanks to those parents who got in touch to say they had received email delivery of the FSM voucher. This is for the first week of the Easter holidays as announced by the Government on 8<sup>th</sup> April. Looking on the system there should be a further email delivery on 17<sup>th</sup> April (for the second week of Easter) and then a third delivery on 20<sup>th</sup> April for the first week of the summer term.
