We will carry out some exciting activities linked to the new early years curriculum. These activities will include a range of PSHE, fine motor, gross motor, craft, phonics, maths and developing curiosity in every area. The children will explore these activities through their learning labs.

PE

Please read with your child as much as possible - it will make a difference to your child's reading progress. We do ask that you read the same book at least 3 times with your child, to build fluency.

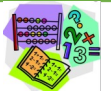


Phonics



Phonics is taught daily. This term we are focusing on phase 1 (listening and attention skills) in preparation for Phase 2, where we begin to look at individual phonemes (letter sounds). Keep a look out on Class Dojo for more information on how you can support your children with this at home.

Maths



In Maths we will be concentrating on numbers up to 10 and this will be taught by 'Number of the Week'.

Children will need to be able to count to 10, order the numbers correctly, count the correct amount with objects and write these numbers accurately. Children will also identify simple patterns.
