PE

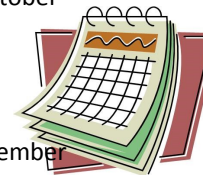

Activity Time in Year 1

Three afternoons a week, we provide play and art & craft activities for the children, alongside a teacher guided activity.

Play is a vital learning tool for our children, providing opportunities for our children to share, imagine and be creative.

ENGLISH

Our writing is linked to our projects and we aim to do a variety of texts, stories, non fiction and poetry.

Spellings are set each week and we test children every Monday. We practise them at school and we expect children to practise them at home. We have four sessions of Whole Class Reading, where we share a text together and explore its vocabulary, meaning and connections.

MATHS

In Maths we are learning about place value to 20 and then 50, including counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

We will be learning how to add and subtract within 20 using different methods. This includes number bonds to 10/20.

We will be introducing the NumBot app to help support the children's learning. Maths homework is given once a week on a Monday.
