


HEADTEACHER'S NEWSLETTER

Start Dates September 2017

School reopens to children in classes 1-12 on Wednesday 6 September 2017 with the following exceptions;

Caterpillars (2 year old provision am and pm) – Existing Caterpillars start back to their usual sessions on Monday 11 September. Caterpillars that are new to the school start with short sessions on Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 September at 10am-11am for morning children, and 1.30pm-2.30pm for afternoon children.

Foundation 1 (Nursery am and pm) – Monday 11 September.

Foundation 2 (Dragonflies and Fireflies) – F2 children start school on Wednesday 6 September from 8.45am -11.50, on Thursday 7 September from 8.45am-12.50 (after having their lunch) and they will be in all day from Friday 8 September.
