- To narrow gaps in attainment and achievement of vulnerable groups; in particular pupils eligible for the pupil premium, pupils with special educational needs and disabilities, looked after pupils and pupils from minority ethnic groups.
- To improve access to ELSA and embed a school wide approach to mental health.
- To narrow gaps in attendance and persistent absenteeism of vulnerable groups.
