### Autumn 2, 2022 - Home Learning Topic Menu

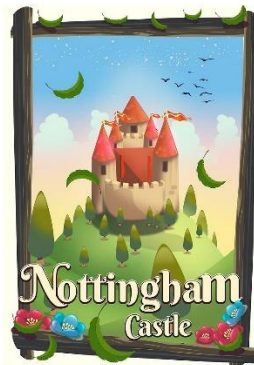

Can you write a **wanted** poster for him? Perhaps you could write a poem about him.

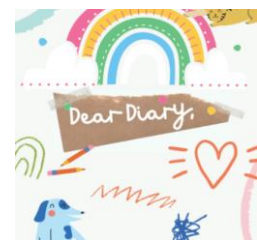
Can you make a collage or silhouette of London in 1666?



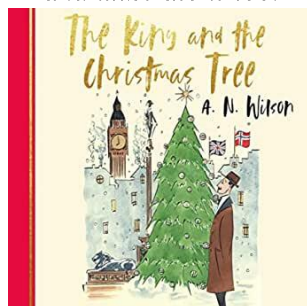
Design and make your own sock puppet nativity animal.
