### What Are We Learning in Year 6?



We finished reading 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty 'Holes' by Louis Sachar.

We are now exploring an anthology of stories called 'Survivors – Extraordinary tales from the Wild and Beyond' by David Long.

In writing, we are looking at another survival story: the journey of Ernest Shackleton as he attempted to cross Antarctica in 1914. We will be writing letters and doing some story writing based on this real-life adventure.

In maths, we will be covering decimals and percentages, as well as lots of revision and work on problem-solving.

Our history focus this term is World War I. We will be learning about the reasons wars start, how they impact the countries involved and how they are resolved.

Our science topic is evolution. We will be looking at the process of evolution and learning about the work of Charles Darwin.

Our music lessons have involved composing music using a variety of media, and learning how music can be used to express identity.

In art we are starting our photography unit on forced perspective – get ready for some tricks of the eye!
