# Learning themes

In our indoor and outdoor Learning Labs the children are encouraged to explore and investigate. They are able to choose what they want to explore, and their learning experience is enhanced and developed through adult open ended questioning. This term our topic is 'Into the woods' where we will be looking at what animals we might see in the woods and talking about what we are frightened off and what foods we like/don't like? In the next half term our topic is 'out of this world' where we will be looking into space, what we might see in the sky and looking at the planets and thinking about how we would get to space.

#### **Phonics**

In phonics we will continue to look at environmental, instrumental sounds and body percussion. We will also be looking more at alliteration and voice sounds. This is where we sound talk to a child e.g. c-a-t and see if they can put these sounds together and tell us the word. If you would like to know more then please ask.

# <u>PE</u>

Miss Swift and the nursery team teach our PE lessons on a Monday afternoon for the Hoverflies, Ladybirds, Butterflies and Caterpillars and on a Thursday morning for the Bumblebees, Ladybirds, Butterflies and Caterpillars. Please remember to send your child in sports clothing and trainers. In PE the children get to use our brand new soft play equipment where we practice jumping, climbing, balancing, moving in different ways etc and turn taking.

# Class Dojo

Each day the staff will post what challenge will be happening in nursery on that day. We also post what we have planned and any events that are happening to ensure everyone is aware and they are just little reminders for everyone.
