

## Funded 2-Year-Old places at Netherfield Primary School

There are 2 ways that parents and carers can access a funded 2-year-old place.

## **30 Funded Nursery Hours for Working Parents**

From September 2025, working parents in England who each earn the equivalent of at least 16 hours per week at the national minimum wage are eligible.

## **15 Funded Nursery Hours**

15 hours of funded childcare for families in receipt of some additional financial support such as:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit and your household income is £15,400 a year or less after tax, not including benefit payments
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, Working Tax Credit (or both) and your household income is £16,190 a year ot less before tax
- Working Tax Credit four-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Your child receives Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or your child has an Education Health Care Plan.
- Children looked after by the Local Authority.

If you're a non-UK citizen who cannot claim benefits and your immigration status says you have 'no recourse to public funds', you may still get free childcare for your 2-year-old. You must live in England and your household income after tax must be no more than:

- £26,500 for families outside of London with one child
- £34,500 for families within London with one child
- £30,600 for families outside of London with two or more children
- £38,600 for families within London with two or more children

If you are eligible, you will receive an email with your eligibility notice.

You will be able to take up your hours from the term after your child turns 2, assuming you meet all the eligibility criteria, and you must have applied for this funding, the term before you would like your child to start. See below:

When you would like your child to start	The deadline to apply for a code
1 January	31 December
1 April	31 March
1 September	31 August
