PROJECT

During the Autumn we will be exploring the theme of **Wonderful Us**. Our learning across the curriculum links to ourselves and where we live. We will look at how people can help us in our local community and about people in the past who help others, we will learn about Mary Seacole and Jesse Boot. The second half term is called **The Box of Forgotten Toys** where we will be learning about toys now and in the past, including the materials toys are made from. We will also be creating moving pictures linking to our Design and Technology.

During the term we will also learn about Jesus and his disciples in our RE lessons, we will also be exploring the festivals of Diwali and Christmas.

MATHS

In maths this term we will be learning about place value to 10 then 20, addition and subtraction within 10 and shapes—both 2D & 3D.

Maths homework is given once a week on a Friday and needs to be returned the following week.

We also do 'snappy maths' which is a 15 minute daily session that focuses on numbers and reasoning skills in maths.
