

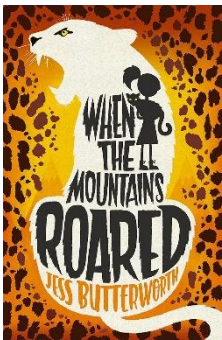
Year 5 Newsletter

In science, we'll be looking at different forces in effect and exploring the vastness of space and our solar system. We're thrilled by the children's enthusiasm for sharing facts they already know!

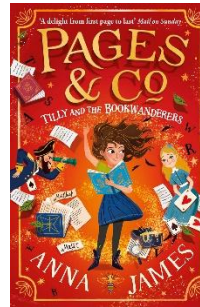

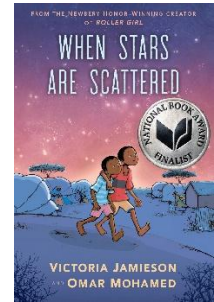
