MATHS

In our daily maths sessions this term we will be learning about place value to 20 then 50, addition and subtraction within 20 and measures including length. Maths homework is given once a week on a Friday

In addition, 8.45-9am is time for 'Morning Maths' where children practise previously taught skills. **If your child arrives on time then they will have 75 mins extra practise in maths a week - and it all counts!** Please arrive on time to give them this chance. Thank you.

PROJECT

Our Spring topics are '**Paws, Claws and Whiskers**' and '**Under the Sea**'. In both topics we will learn about different animals and animal families. In spring 1 our art will be based around Steve Brown and the use of colour as well as learning about how weather affects animals as well as us! In spring 2 we venture under the sea and investigate which seas are around the UK, how we can protect them and why oceans are so important.
