Phonics

This term we will be teaching daily phonic lessons, starting with Phase 2. We teach the children how to say and write each letter. The phoneme is how we say the letter sound and the grapheme is how we write the letter.

Reading

We want children to develop a love of reading. We read and share books every day in class and love hearing what their favourite books are.

The children will also bring a 'Reading for Pleasure' book home to share with you. We know life is busy, but 10 minutes a day sharing a book together, really does make a huge impact.

Maths

In maths

the children will be learning to match, sort and compare objects and pictures. We will be talking about measure and patterns. We will also be looking at shapes and numbers up to 5. When looking at numbers, we will be counting, matching written numerals and objects and recognising 1 more and one less.
